23rd AUGUST: AN OUTDOOR MASS WILL BE HELD AT ST MARGARET CLITHEROW'S DUFFIELD IF THERE IS THE PROSPECT OF GOOD WEATHER PLUS SUFFICIENT SUPPORT TO MAKE IT VIABLE: **DEADLINE FOR BOOKING A PLACE FOR THIS MASS IS MONDAY 10th AUGUST 12 NOON (see overleaf)**

WEARING FACE MASKS IN CHURCH On Friday 31st July, the Government announced that the wearing of face coverings was now to be recommended straight away in a number of indoor settings, including places of worship. This is now required by law, as from Saturday 8th August.

PLANS FOR AN OUTDOOR MASS THIS AUGUST An organising committee met last week to assess the suitability of the site at St Margaret Clitherow's, Duffield for an outdoor Mass in August. The date in view is Sunday 23rd August, at 11am. *Bookings will be necessary to comply with statutory regulations and health requirements, stating the names and numbers wishing to attend in each group.* Volunteers from the Parish Telephone Tree have been asked to be in touch with all their contacts over the present weekend and to feedback names and numbers. **THE DEADLINE FOR BOOKING A PLACE AT THE MASS IS 12noon ON MONDAY 10th AUGUST.** The Committee will assess on Tuesday 11th whether there is enough interest to make the outdoor Mass viable. Please note that in the event of heavy rain or strong winds being forecast, it may have to be cancelled. Should this happen, anyone who has booked a place will be informed.

TO BOOK A PLACE AT MASS ON SUNDAYS

- Bookings will be taken between Monday 9am and Thursday 9pm **a week in advance**
- **Bookings can be made either by email to: office@catholic-ambervalley.uk or by ringing 01773 822182 and leaving a voicemail message**
- Whether booking by phone or by email you must:
 - Say who wishes to come, giving the name of each person
 - Indicate, if more than one, whether they can sit together
 - Give full contact details: these are required to be kept for three weeks after the Mass as part of the Government's track and trace system

Bookings will be taken on a first come, first served basis – and only for the week in advance, not beyond.

STREAMED MASSES: Since streamed Masses from the Parish began in early June they have attracted more than 1700 viewers! It is hoped these will continue to be made available most Sundays for the foreseeable future, as detailed on the front page of each week's bulletin.

NO MASS ON 30th AUGUST Fr Michael will be taking a break from parish duties from Monday 24th August to Saturday 5th September. *During that period there will be no public Masses.* On Sunday 30th August it is hoped that a streamed virtual Mass will be available online.
